Is Africa Rising? Has the African Anatomy overcome the woes caused during the Neo-Colonialism Era? How is Africa performing relatively on the Global level? We have great Giants in Africa, who have decided not to stretch themselves to pursue greater heights. This has resulted in many innovations coming out from people in other continents. This has also kept young and growing ones, from pursuing their visions, because they feel, they will not get anywhere. The whole of Africa is free now from Colonial rule. Post Independence in the nations of the African Anatomy, how are we still performing? Are we better, worse off or we are doing marvellously well? **AFRICAN VOICES INTERNATIONAL** is concerned with the Growth and Development of Africa, now. We can emerge into independent leaders. We can emerge into phenomenal nations. This is the time. Kwame Nkrumah in his fight for Independence in Ghana said, Gold Coast at the time wanted Self Government immediately. That's the same way, we want total Independency and self-reliance, now. This is how the whole of Africa can enjoy good and luxuriant styles of living. The time is now, and Africa must rise. We must push up. We must not settle for less. There must be a combined effort by the Government and citizenry, to push higher, in all areas and walks of life. There must be greater freedom in Africa. We cannot be humiliated. We cannot be living in Poverty. This is the time. The time is now! **AFRICAN VOICES INTERNATIONAL** entreats all Africans to step forward and make impact, for the growth and development of the Anatomy. We must be radical! We must be indefatigable if we want to see the Africa our forefathers and mothers have all dreamed of.

Post the Independence story in the African Anatomy, which was mostly between 1957 and 1965 till now, Africa has come a long way to be able to prove to the entire Global Anatomy that, Africa is a standing force that can be able to determine and shape the Global Economy. However, it looks like Africa has been at a standstill economically, and has still been a dependent Anatomy, that is not thriving. There are certain loopholes that are still in our anatomy that needs to be corrected. **AFRICAN VOICES INTERNATIONAL** is committed to standing tall to make the African Anatomy, a self reliant and economically viable and prosperous anatomy. Yes, we can and these are the factors, we can work on, to see a change, in the African Anatomy.

THE AFRICAN OPERATION

The African Anatomy post Independence has been stagnant in economic growth. In 1975, there were about 1975 million poor africans. During this period, one out of ten people were living in Africa. In Ghana's case, the National Anatomy was having the same level of GDP Per Capita in 1957 as just compared to South Korea. The economy of Ghana retrogressed and keep on declining through to 1983 where the economy almost collapsed. Inflation during that period was about 123%. In 2000, Ghana's real GDP growth retrogressed to 3.7%. In 1993, the Government of Ghana set up measures to become an upper middle income country by 2020.

That needed a GDP rate of 8% yearly, but Ghana's GDP rate is at 4.64% currently as even, in 2021. In 2018 Nigeria's GDP rate was 1.9%, whilst Ethiopia's was 6.8% and South Africa's was 0.8. In 2019, Nigeria's GDP rate was 2.2%, Ethiopia's 8.4% and South Africa's 0.2. African Economies have not been able to take extreme strides that will cause their economies to grow at a higher increasing rate, and revamp their economies. In 2019, GDP rate of Uganda was at 8.1%. In 2020 the GDP rate went to a negative level at -2.1%. In 2021, it has risen to 6.35% and there it is decelerating to 4.9% for 2022. We need formidable structures, that will set our rates going extremely high for the change, we need.

The African Story has been less impressive so far, because African leaders and citizens most importantly have not taken the matter of changing the African Story so far, as urgent as possible. All policies geared towards achieving our Agendas have at a point in time, been diverted to pursue other goals. We have no back up plans, that gives us alternate measures to resolve urgent situations as well that comes our way, in the course of pursuing our long term plans and agendas. As a result of this, we always come to a halt, because budgets allocated for specific purposes in our regions, are diverted to see to emergent issues, which come our way, in the course of National Service. It is about time, we rise up to be proactive and directional enough to be able to resolve unforeseen and future alerts, that may come our way, in the course of seeing to the stability of our nation's economies.

SHORTFALLS IN THE AFRICAN ANATOMY

1. STYLE OF LEADERSHIP

The leadership of most African countries, post Independence has had a question to its rule. Most leaders have failed to give meaning to why they took power. They have ruled their countries harshly and squandered most of their country's money, into their personal pockets. Most Governments in Africa are almost bankrupt and suffering from abject poverty, because of how the leaders have directed the finances of their countries. Leaders like Teodoro Nguema Mbasongo of Guinea and Jose Eduardo Dos Santos who ruled Angola in 1979 have been an embarrassment to the dignity of the African Anatomy. Idi Amin of Uganda who ruled his country from 1971 to 1979 suspended parts of his country's constitution to favour himself, squandered Government money and gave some to the Military, because he was a Major General in the Ugandan Army, before leading a coup in 1971 to gain power as Head of State. During his eight years rule, he had about 80000 to 300000 people being killed. Francisco Nguema who was Head of State for Equatorial Guinea from 1968 to 1979 led his country dictatorially. He had no trust for educated people and therefore did not appoint such people to power. About one third of his population were killed during his reign. General Sani Abacha of Nigeria who ruled from 1993 to 1998 was a dictator. He implemented a decree that made him be able to imprison anyone without trial, for three months. Poverty was absolute during his time. Nigeria was in darkness since the day he took power in November 1993 17th. Omar Al Bashir of Sudan was also a corrupt leader who had murder, torture and gross human rights abuses, very normal during his time. In 1996, he was the only person by law, made to stand as a Political Candidate, which made him the Elections. Our leadership had been bad and continues to be worse. We need to rise up, and celebrate the Freedom, we fought for.

2. MISAPPROPRIATION OF FUNDS

African leaders have mismanaged after gaining Independence and leading their countries, in Freedom. They have rather thwarted the course of Freedom, in their countries, instead of protecting the Freedom that have been passed on from some of our Legendary heroes. Most of our leaders have misused state funds and have left their countries in abject poverty. Ex-President Yahya Jammeh of Gambia took \$111m which is equivalent to £8.8m and €10.3m, from the state coffex. He was still in office for about two months, even after loosing the Presidential Elections. The essence of Freedom in our National Anatomies has been misdefined by our leaders and misunderstood by the populace. Africa continues to retrogress. **AFRICAN VOICES INTERNATIONAL** entreats us to be circumspect of how we manage our country, for a better future in Africa. Africa is the next Regionalism od hope and Freedom, and it can only be done by we being Integral citizens towards National Development, Just and Fair citizens as well as being transparent, in all our dealings.

3. MISUNITY

Africans are disunited everywhere in the Global Anatomy. Africans from different countries, who meet in another continent, do not recognise themselves as siblings of the same blood, but as strangers. Africans who visit other african countries are seen as strangers, and not given the kind of love and hospitality, they need. Rather, Africans give their all to foreigners, and treat them as idols and this is what allows them to humiliate and take advantage of us. This is because, we do not respect ourselves. There are a lot of African Giants with great ideas that can transform our economies, and make us indeed a Self-Reliant people. Unfortunately, the Government does not in any way, give support to such people and neither do citizens also hail their own, but hail other ones. We intentionally create divisions amongst ourselves, and these are the loopholes, which pave the way for foreigners, to proceed with the Gross Disrespect, they show to us.

4. LANGUAGE BARRIERS

The African Anatomy has become divided as a result of the language barriers we have. We have a lot of languages which are recognised internationally, which are so much unfamiliar amongst other members of the African family. Colonial leaders left their languages in the territories, they invaded. Now members of the African Anatomy, no more see themselves as one. 5. FOREIGN INTRUSION AND EXPLOITATION

The African Anatomy has always far before time, been characterised with mediocrity. We have all the time, lost our sense of worth. We do not appreciate our cultures, identity, leadership style and way of living. We have always seen foreigners a the most phenomenal, and allowed them to dictate to us, how we should lead our economies and live our lives. We have always discouraged our own

from going forward and have given the nod to foreigners to exploit us. This has led us to where we are and has made us captives to foreigners. It is about time, we rise up. **AFRICAN VOICES INTERNATIONAL** believes Africans are excellent and very phenomenal. We are need less and priceless and we must walk in unity to bring forth the kind of self-reliant anatomy, we want in Africa.
