THE ONE AFRICA FREEDOM DIALOGUE
REPORT ON RECONCILIATION BETWEEN
BLACKS AND WHITES



Blacks over a long time have gone through various forms of oppressions, humiliation, abuse and mental torture as a result of the debilitating dispositions poised by Whites during the Colonial Era. The level of abductions, atrocities, murder, violence caused to Blacks has brought so much pain to Blacks. Blacks

have felt neglected and abandoned in every structure and setting of Governance. This has crept into the hearts and minds of children growing up ,who have taken themselves to be imperfect except Whites. Blacks had developed a mediocre mentality which has led to the impoverishment of their resources and brought African economies to a stand still, because of all the atrocities, they passed through. Blacks over the past years, post the Independence Era, have become bitter and out of trust with the Whites Anatomy. However, the need for us to grow strong can only be better when we stand united. There are a whole lot of whites, who have come to meet this history and totally out of such violent dispositions

There are a section of Whites who are willing to stand together with Blacks and live unitedly with Blacks in the Global Anatomy, for a better and brighter future for all sundry. This can only come through a Reconciliatory process. **THE ONE AFRICA FREEDOM DIALOGUE** was held on 14th February, 2022 to create a structural plan for Whites

and Blacks to stand together for the needed change of Tranquility, Harmony and Solidarity to be affirmed between Blacks and Whites, for a united Global Anatomy.



The change we want to see in the Global Anatomy, can only happen when we begin to walk together, respect each other as one people, love each other genuinely and confront matters that bring divisions

amongst ourselves on international front. The time has come for all of us, to indeed walk in harmony with each other. We can all do a lot together. Each race is relevant and must be given the space to express themselves to the highest order. Each race's culture is unique and must be respected. Each race has unique people of diverse kinds to bring various remedies in the Global Anatomy in all ministries of Governance, and it is only when we begin to tackle matters that brings rivalries amongst ourselves, and resolve them, can we walk as one people holistically.

RECONCILIATION



RECONCILIATION is the process by which both parties involved in a conflict, dispute or misunderstanding come together to settle issues amicably and make peace to live as one people. Reconciliation brings harmony, tranquility and order in the society. Reconciliation brings to an end all kinds of trajectories in the society that has kept people and continents in pain, agony, and segmented people within the Global Anatomy, from each other. Reconciliation brings fairness and keeps each Party in soundness.

There are various things that make bring enmity or bitterness amongst various parties. Blacks have been bitter for a long time over all that has happened and have been at loggerheads over a long time for the harsh treatments, meted on them during periods of



colonisation. However, no matter what as a Global Anatomy, we must be linked to each other. We must function cooperatively and in unity with a genuine mind, for the change we want to see.

In order to reach a balanced world, we need to highlight the issues that have brought various challenges amongst our relationships. There needs to be a fair world where people are not categorised and dehumanised on their racial lines, skin colour or even economic lines. The various factors expounded below are what have brought various forms of divisions between the Black race and Whites.



1. SYSTEM OF EXPLOITATION



Africa has already been a wealthy continent even before colonial leaders came. Africans were United and living in peace. Africa had everything to live in peace without any form of help. However, we were exploited. Whites came to take advantage of Africa's hospitality and made a fool of Africans. The continent has always been filled with all the resources needed for Good and Comfortable living. However, things have come to shambles since Africans begun to show their good faces to Whites

This has kept Blacks in bitterness and most Africans do not even want to offer a helping hand, wherever they are to Whites. There are a few examples that will be cited to show how Whites exploited Blacks, on their own land. In Zimbabwe formerly known as the Ndebele Kingdom, a deal was agreed between the Chief of the Ndebele Kingdom; Lobengula, and the British South Africa Company to have full shares of the Mineral and Metal Resources of the Ndebele Kingdom. Sooner or later from then, Chief Lobengula realised that this was a crafty deal and wanted to nullify the deal but Cecil Rhodes had already gone to Great Britain to obtain a Monopolist Royal Charter and begun to ill treat the people as they colonised the territory.



Between 1898 and 1931, the budget on roads and railways in Ghana took about 30.5% of the budget of Masters within the Colonial Regime. These railroads were constructed mainly to serve as a passage route to the ports, harbours, shores and the Castles as well as Forts of Colonial Leaders, ready for shipping and transportation to their countries. The railroads were not constructed to help African countries but rather to extract from Africans. Extraction was the main mind behind these actions of Whites. They came to

make Africans feel inferior and build a White-Supremacist ideology for all to worship. These railroads constructed by them were used to transport African's cocoa, rubber, coffee, palm oil, minerals and fruits to their countries. The British came to exploit and degrade us. They came for their own hidden motives finish and leave back. That is what they wanted. Most development projects were done for their personal gains and not realistically for the benefit of the Nations, they were in. These Whites mostly opened the doors for their own brothers to have masses of land and denied Blacks from acquiring lands. Africans were dejected to the lowest pedestal in life, and made to suffer for their rights. There are a lot of vast productive centres in Africa that have been taken over by Whited and are being used for their parochial interests, at the expense of mass poverty, happening in Africa.

The Harm caused to Africans was abysmal and these are some of the dispositions that brings enmity and

rivalry amongst parties. Various parties are supposed to negotiate fairly with each other and act on a Just course rather than exploiting each other. We must stand for the course of Freedom and Justice. We must unite, save our own and fight for the Freedom of our land at all times. Mental Slavery has been the order of the day. Africans have lost their identity because they have been derailed of their own cultures and this must come to an abrupt end! Africa must shine from now. We must reignite the passion for change. Africans are special and must cherish themselves at all times. We must fight for our own.

2. ABUSE OF HUMAN RIGHTS



Blacks are special beings yet they have been dehumanised on all fronts in social relations. Blacks have been abused and made to look and live like animals. This has served as a deterrent for Blacks to move and walk with Whites for the sustenance of Freedom. About 12 million Blacks were evacuated from Africa to America and never were able to trace their lineages or roots. Most of them were dehumanised on the journey through the Middle Passage to America. They were raped, beaten, poisoned and assaulted. Some died along the

journey. Some had their children stolen. They were all mixed and could not speak to each other since they had different languages. They were taken as slaves and made to adopt a foreign language, known as English and adopt it as their official language. They were beaten, lashed and chained like criminals across the journey. They never came back where they left from; Doors of No Return. Today, Whites have the stand to still see Blacks as uncourageous people.

Sarah Baartman who lived from 1789 to 1815, was a South African Khoekhoe Woman, who was transported to Britain, sexually assaulted and had her body displayed for Whites to see. Her body was displayed for Whites to see, because of her “magnanimous” entire human anatomy. Both parent of Sarah Baartman died and as a result, she had to fight hard to find a good square meal each day. Life was not easy for her. She was influenced by a Black Trader by name Peter Caesars who took her away

from her Hometown, Camdeboo to Cape Town where she became a Maid to Peter Caesars and other people in the neighbourhood. She also became a maid and a wet nurse to Peter Caesars brother by name, Hendrick Caesars. She had her rights suppressed and infringed upon in various ways. She was forced to go to Britain by a Surgeon by name Alexander Dunlop, who was introduced to him by Hendrik Caesars. Sarah Baartman was ridiculed to the highest degree. Her body was used as a public display in Britain and later on in France. Blacks were tortured and mistreated and Whites were seen as superior beings at the time. This was very shameful to the Human Race, as other people of skin colour were made to feel low whilst others were made to feel good and better off. The need for the immediate end of all these insubordinate acts must take a place, as a matter of urgency. Africa must rise up again. The chains must be broken and Blacks must return to their rightful place. Stephen Clarke was shot by the Police in California after Police came up on him during their investigations

following the search for a break in, in the neighbourhood. George Floyd had his a Police's knee bent on his neck for about nine minutes, in Minneapolis. He died shortly after the incident. Stephen Clarke was even shot at least about 7 times in California. Philando Castile was killed by the Police whilst driving in St. Paul, Minnesota. All these horrible scenes displayed the Police, happened in United States of America. Whilst George Floyd was being abused, he made the Police aware that he was losing his breath, but they never took caution or even gave him little space, for him to have his way.



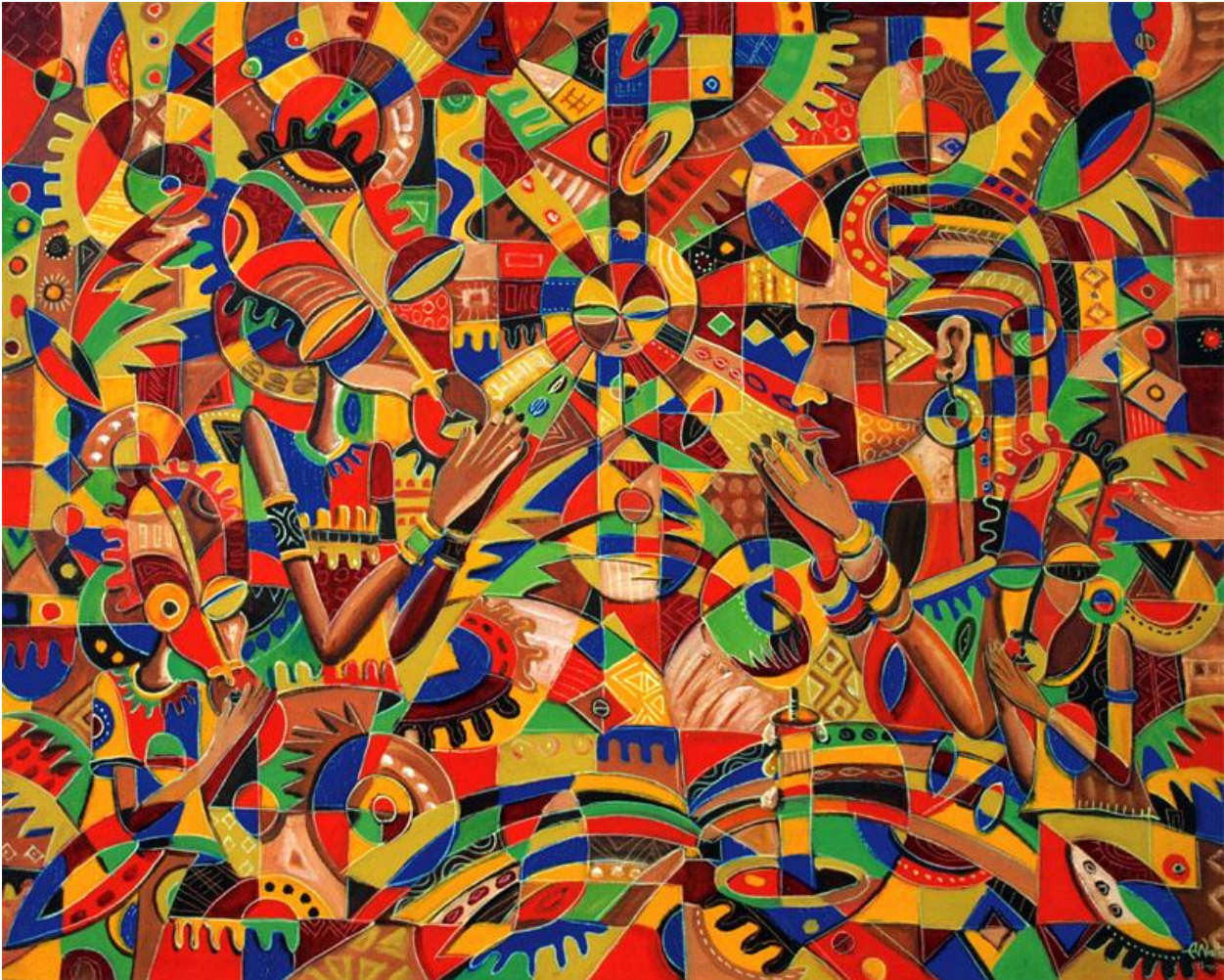
James Marian Sims who used Blacks as a platform to make his career a better one. He exploited and used Blacks for Rehearsals. As a Surgeon, he worked on Blacks without any form of sedative drug or using anaesthesia on them. He wanted Black Women to go through intense pain and will always work on them without work. That was his modus operandi of

becoming a renowned Surgeon; by experimenting on Black Women. He clearly segmentated Blacks from Whites and made a fool out of Blacks, as a Gynaecologist. These are but a few examples of how Whites treated Blacks. Whites were made to see themselves as gods in front of Blacks.



If we want to have a better future, then all these faults must be accepted, regretted with the solemn declaration and stance for such acts, never to be done again. That's how we can build a better Global Anatomy.

3. RACIAL DISCRIMINATION



Right from the Political Anatomy to all forms of social jurisdictions in the world are filled with all forms of oppressions that has kept the world in various forms of unwarranted divisions, which are killing us slowly. Blacks have been discriminated on certain fronts for a while and so have Whites been

also discriminated on certain fronts. All these must end for the change of modesty and sound living, we want in the world. We all need to understand ourselves as one people, with a common destiny.

Between 1948 to 1994 was a distasteful time in the lives of South Africans as the National Party of South Africa ruled harshly as Governmental leaders of the South African country. There were discriminative economic and social practices placed upon Blacks which made life distasteful for them. The Population Registration Act of 1950, put people in South Africa into various divisions based on the colour of their skin. The divisions were into four which placed people into White, Bantu, Mixed, Asian. People who had parents being both Blacks and Whites were termed as Coloured because they had mixed races. The divisions were meant to entangle the Bantus into colonial oppression, through the various reforms Colonial leaders created. Blacks were impoverished of their rights. Marriages between

Blacks and Whites were abolished. The participation of Blacks in Governmental Dialogues were abolished. Blacks were ruled to live in certain places and Whites were the ones only allowed to live in certain places in the country. Blacks who were without Passports that gave them the “right,” by the Government to live in certain places were put in jail. Public Properties and Services were privileged for only White consumption whilst Blacks were made to suffer or pay more for such quality services. There was an act implemented as the Immorality Acts implemented in 1927 and reviewed in 1950, where people who were found guilty of being in mixed relationships were sent to prison. These were the horrible incidents happening in the Southern terrain of the African Anatomy.

In the United States of America, we also have Legendary Rosa Parks born on February 5, 1913 and died on October 24, 2005. There were laws during her youthful age that made only Whites sit in front

in a bus, whilst Blacks were made to sit at the backs. Blacks were seen as outsiders, slaves, servants, foolish and useless people. Rosa Parks one day in a bus sat in one of the front seats, when she took a bus. After this stance, she was questioned by a White who questioned her for sitting in front as a Black. She got angry and fought over this and took the case to Court and through her Relentlessness, this Law was eschewed.

The oppressions were a lot all over the Global Anatomy. The Injustices were a lot. The evil strengths were a lot. The pain caused to Blacks were a lot. But today, Blacks have overcome this and this is why Blacks call for Reconciliation process. Blacks are saying they have forgotten about the pain and are ready to walk unitedly again with Whites, if they will not be exploited again. Blacks also promise to act justly with Whites and live with them as one people.



ROLES EACH PARTY NEEDS TO PLAY AT ALL TIMES, IN THE RECONCILIATION PROCESS

1. SENSE OF UNDERSTANDING

There must be a sense of positive understanding between Blacks and Whites. We all need to function as one army in the Global Anatomy, that respect each other and are willing to walk and hold each others hands. We must carry our differences with a sense of respect. We must respect and value the

treasures, resources in every continent and not be jealous and treacherous to each other. Rather we must use what we have to promote Development in the Global Anatomy and as well ensure accorded agreements that signify the mutual respect and the dignity of each races.

2. FAIRNESS

As members of the Global Anatomy, we must be fair to each other. We must walk together as people who do not take biased actions or talk badly. We have to make sure we treat each other fairly and ensure that everyone is accountable to Democratic and Political Freedom, in our states. We must be able to open our ears to everyone fairly and listen to what people have to say. We must listen attentively to the views of others. We must give credence to the views of others. We have to ensure that everyone's dignity is secured. This is how we can say that indeed the Reconciliation process is happening. We must allow everyone to have the dignity of a fair

and just life, throughout their lifetime. We must stand tall for change and believe in the course of Freedom in the Global Anatomy.

3. NEUTRAL AID

The Global Anatomy must be characterized with global partnerships that are void of exploitation. We must have negotiations and trade agreements that are fair and that signify our hearts for each other, and not for reasons of exploiting each other. We must stand tall for neutral change at every point in time, and desist from exploiting our partners. We must think of how our states can be developed and rather provide aid for communities that are less deprived of various resources. We must make underdeveloped communities become First-Class centres and build a world, where every part of the world is fully developed to the brim. This should be our mind and not exploiting from other communities to make our suburbs better at the expense of others. We must not work towards being superior to each other, but towards building an excellent

equitable First Class Structure for all Regions in the countries of our world. That is how the Global Anatomy, can be better.

4. UNITY

We must begin to act as an Anatomy bonded by unity that are void of authoritarianism and support democracies. We must put an end to all forms of racial segregations and live as one people with a common goal. We must end all forms of oppressions and love each other, respect each other and give humanity, a better life to live in. We tear ourselves down through various divisions but we move forward and open up spaces for advanced development when we live as one people, with a common purpose and goal.

5. LOVE

Peace will be the order of the day, if we begin to walk in Love as one people. We must be able to operate in an Open Democracy where we do not put preconceived ideas into our minds, but allow each

other to express themselves and live as a people who truly walk in Freedom. We must be able to signify a sense of hope for this new era, we live in. We must be able to say to each other, “Blacks can and Whites can,” equally for the monumental change we want to see. We must imbibe confidence in the hearts of all races for the changes, we need.



AFRICAN VOICES INTERNATIONAL strongly believes that, if each of these roles are practiced, no race will serve as a threat to each other. Rather, there will be Peace and Unity amongst ourselves. We will live as one people who do not even in any take racial differences into consideration. We should always have the mental consciousness that we are one people in the Global Anatomy, who respect each other, value ourselves and live together as an Anatomy fully bonded by Genuine Aids and Justice.

The Global Freedom Board of **AFRICAN VOICES INTERNATIONAL** has introduced a Memorandum of Understanding to sustain the process of Democratic Freedom in the Global Anatomy. This Memorandum of Understanding has been implemented between Blacks and Whites that will promote the form of Reconciliation Process, we want to see as people in the Global Anatomy. The Memorandum of Understanding known as AVI ACT 1.0 to facilitate the process of suitable right and

mental transient upbringings between Blacks and Whites. **AFRICAN VOICES INTERNATIONAL** entreats all people to respect this Memorandum of Understanding, follow suit to it and be agents of change, in the Global Anatomy.

RECONCILIATION MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (AVI ACT 1.0)

The Global Freedom Board of **AFRICAN VOICES INTERNATIONAL** has set this **RECONCILIATION ACT** out of **THE ONE AFRICA FREEDOM DIALOGUE** on the Topic, **RECONCILIATION BETWEEN BLACKS AND WHITES**, to enable Freedom Giants feel sufficient and unperturbed as they travel throughout the Global Anatomy, knowing Whites will at all times, hold their hands in their country. This Act is to affirm on the side of all White Freedom Giants, their appendage to no act of Imperialism, Discrimination, Injustice, Humiliation, Abuse, Inequality, Political Discrepancy or Sabotages of any kind.

In this Act, all Blacks and Whites shall append to these statements,

- I shall not discriminate anyone based on the colour of his skin.
- I shall welcome every foreigner, from the Global Anatomy in my country and home, with Love.
- I shall not ridicule any race or colour of people.
- I shall live in Tranquility with all people.
- I shall treat Africans with Love and without any act or trait, of partiality.
- I shall ensure that my neighbours live in Peace.
- I shall not be an impediment to the Peace and Harmony of any Human Being

- I shall treat every one of different skin colour who enters my country, with respect.
- I shall put the Laws of the country first over all my personal philosophies, and act with no prejudicial principles.
- I shall see myself as equal to all human beings and treat each human being with respect, in regards to the choices and pursuits they take, in life.
- I shall help people and not extract from them, but to help them freely and willingly.
- I shall not hold any grudge that has been settled against anyone.

This petition seeks to bring to the minds of all sundry to live with purpose as a people of Unity, in the Global Anatomy. All forms of Xenophobia, Discrimination and Partiality should be a thing of the past. We must encourage Intra-Regional Harmony

and live as one people without any line that tears us, apart as a people, within the Global Anatomy. The Global Freedom Board of **AFRICAN VOICES INTERNATIONAL** entreats all Freedom Giants to sign this Memorandum of Understanding as a Petition, through this link; <https://chng.it/DXntShjq>

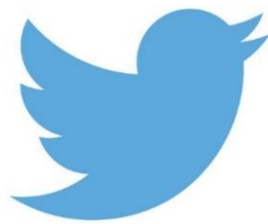

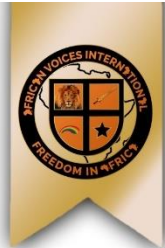
