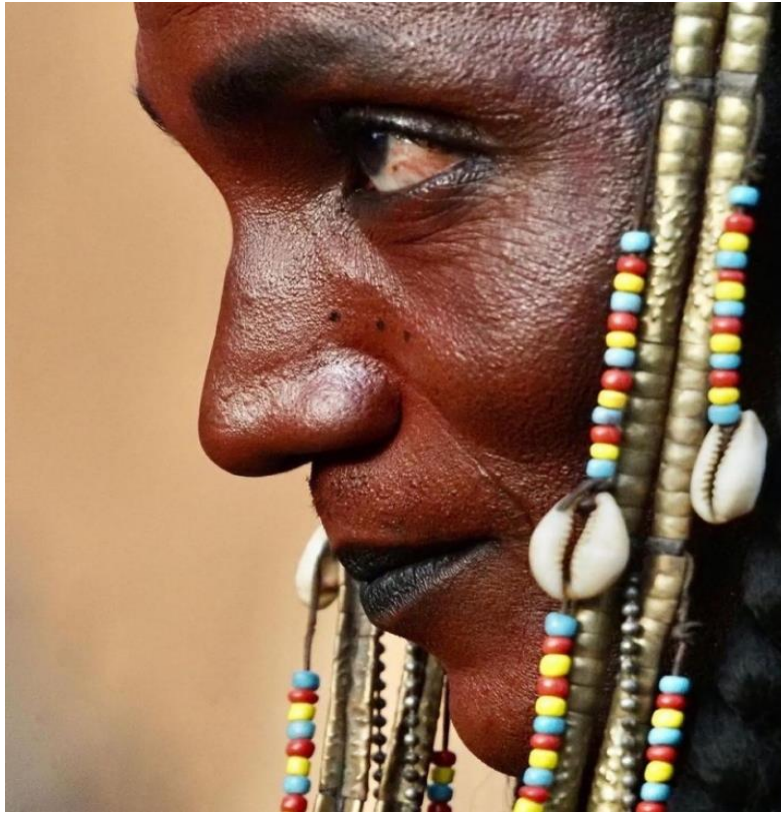

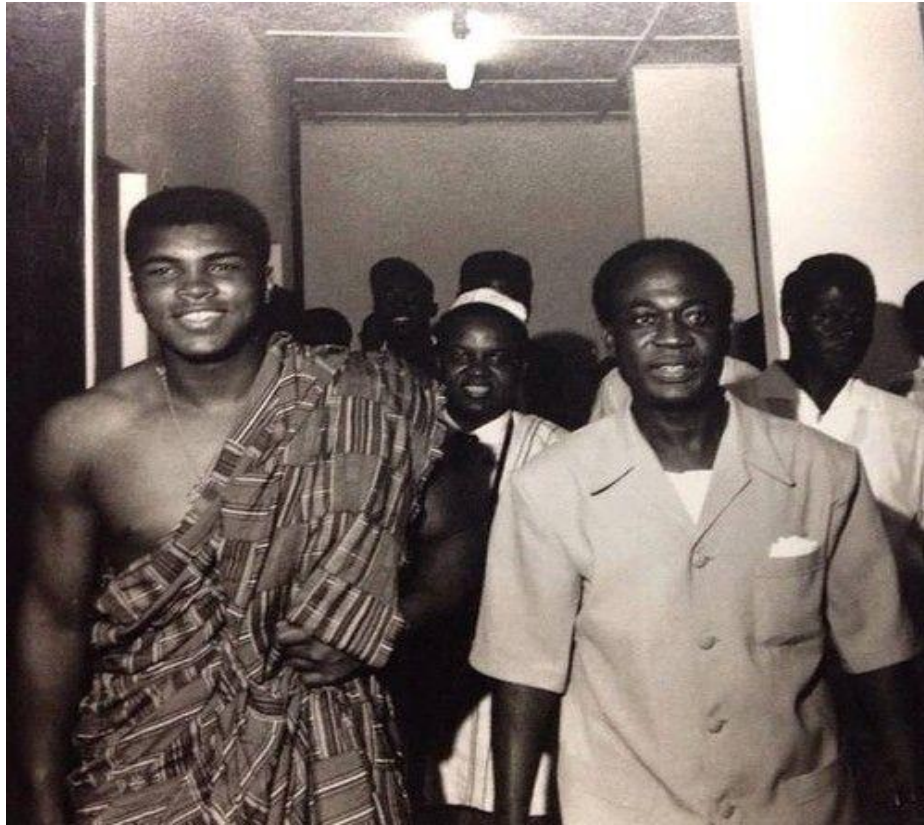


EXERCISING AND EMPHASISING THE PRINCIPLE OF INTEGRITY AND ACCOUNTABILITY
