

REPORT ON THE FREEDOM NATIONAL DIALOGUE

On Saturday, the 15th of February, 2020, **YOUTH IN ACTION** organised her first dialogue, dubbed, **THE FREEDOM NATIONAL DIALOGUE**, at the New Conference Hall of the Ghana National Association of Teachers' Hall, on the topic, "**DEMOCRACY AND ITS EFFECTS ON GOOD GOVERNANCE"**. The purpose of the conference was to engage the youth, as active democratic stakeholders in Nation Building.

Democracy does not belong to particular class or age of people, but to the whole populace; the child, teenager, youth, adult, abled, aged, majority and minority in the society. The Youth of Africa, who are the main point of focus, in YOUTH IN ACTION, are part of the society, and have the right to express themselves and engage in various decision making forums and settings of all sorts. This conference was meant to empower the BLACK YOUTH, to believe in themselves and take up initiatives that will transform the globe. The conference took the form of a Dialogue amongst various Youth Panellists, together with the public and various stakeholders in Governance. THE CONCEPT OF DEMOCRACY

DEFINITION OF DEMOCRACY

Democracy according to Abraham Lincoln is the system of government of the people where the people are the main channels of power, by the people where there are representatives for the people in Governance or by direct rule where the people exercise power by themselves, and for the people where power is exercised to serve the interests of the people.

Or

Democracy is a system of Government where Freedom thrives in the system and foundation of the Governing Administration, which enables citizens of the particular anatomy to express their views without fear of being ignored or being attacked.

Or

Democracy is the freedom based system of political administration where power is in the hands of the people which enables them to take decisions for the nation through elected representatives or directly by them.

FEATURES OF DEMOCRACY

1. Multi-party System

In every democratic system, there is a multi-party system. There must be the presence of various parties with their own philosophies and manifestoes, about how they want the nation to be steered and administered. A single party system must never be accepted in the governing process. There will always be societies and groups of people who will want to also run the nation, sincerely and their views must be heard. They must be considered as part of the nation, and given the nod to partake in elections for the citizenry to decide who takes which party wins for her presidential candidate, to take office as the president of the country. **YOUTH IN ACTION**, believes that

multi-party system is a factor in democracy that proves the freedom of a nation's members or citizenry. YOUTH IN ACTION, believes that a multiparty system is quintessential for the thriving of a well-developed nation. **YOUTH IN ACTION**, believes and points out to the entire populace that, just as the Multi-Party System thrives in a Government, so should it be so in our society starting from the family. The father must not be the only voice in the family. Neither must the mother be the only additional voice to the Dad. The entire family; children, cousins, nephews, including the house help/maid should add to the voice of the family's decision. Everybody is quintessential to humanity and must not be seen as significant in decision making. They all have a part to play, and their presence alone serves as an anchor to shape the path, at which the leader of the family must go. This delves down to promote human equality and Gender Equality. The wife must not be taken for granted, and be side-lined with an excuse to her gender. She may have the requisite experience to turn the path of the family. YOUTH IN ACTION believes that she may be side-lined and this will lead to the family's retrogression, conflict amongst each other and biasness. Freedom must prevail in the family. In Education, no school must feel superior to the other. University of Cape Coast must not fill bigger than KNUST or RADFORD University, and so should KNUST not fill bigger over UDS or UCC and likewise. There should be decency in our way of living. A graduate from a particular school must not be given a preferential treatment over the other. The nation will grow if we live with the right dispositions.

2. FREEDOM OF SPEECH

YOUTH IN ACTION, as a significant feature of countries that want to thrive in Democracy. YOUTH IN ACTION, believes that if the nations in the African continent want to thrive well, then each part; age group, jobs in the public and private sector, in the class of our national anatomies must be given the requisite privilege to air out their views of national concern. YOUTH IN ACTION believes in fairness and the liberty of every individual, group, society and nation. People must be bold to stand out for the truth even if

they are left alone, without fear of retaliation. **YOUTH IN ACTION** believes that there must be the utmost legal liberty of every individual; child, teenager, youth, adult or aged, to speak out their views about how to resolve persisting challenges in the continent. The continent does not belong to a select hand number of people. The continent belongs to the entire citizenry within the African Political Anatomy. Hence, it will be inerrant for people with mind blowing ideas, for solving the needs of the continent, to be quiet, still and watch what is going on. Let us stand up, particularly the youth of Africa, and contribute our quota. Let us rise in action. This is the time. This is the season for Africa. Let us revolutionaries the whole system into her perfect administered one. People must be able to let our their concerns and worries. The welfare of the nation as a whole must be our concern and not the welfare of a secluded majority or certain august kinds of people who want to feel superior to the laws of the country. The laws must be supreme to everybody. Everyone deserves sanctity and equality in every administrative structure of governance in the country. The youth must be daring. They must open up their minds to productive ventures around the world, and make impact.

3. FREE AND FAIR ELECTIONS

In a democratic system, free and fair elections is a major feature that prevails and has a permanent mark in the foundational structure of the Government, in a sustained democratic system. This is because these elections reflect the power and decision of the populace as they express their power through their votes. It moves in that way. There must be accountable system of validating candidates based on their quality of their durational tenure. This will promote a competitive system of excellence in governance that will boost quality democratic Governance across the Continent. Anywhere on the earth, where there are unfair and unfree elections is a detriment to the democratic progression of humanity in the society. The Quality of work by the leaders of our various Governments, must be tested each now and then. This is to create a progressive trend of constant development through creativity, innovation and new inventions by our leaders. Positions in Government



must not be the dreams of our citizens. Causing changes in the system must be their dreams. We have a lot of leaders who have been away from fulfilling their campaign promises and just enjoy the luxury associated with their position. As a result, there must be continuous elections to take off from political power, leaders who come with unrealistic policies, and expect to be honoured as successful leaders. Our Democracy must teach the people of the nation to live in discipline and integrity. We must create a foundation of excellence, wherever we are. Honour comes with followership and as a result, Governments who work tirelessly to fulfil their promises and take the country from one level of development to another level of development will be kept in power during elections unless, the nation wants to try an equally promising but different political party with different doctrines or philosophies. Free and fair elections will serve as an anchor for competitive functioning in Governments of African Countries and different parties within a nation, which will breed healthy national growths in all areas of administrative power in our African nations. Political biases, Superiority complexes, poor Government functionings, Racial Discriminations, Gender Inequalities, and all kinds of Injustices in the nation will not promote and strengthen the kind of democracy we want. YOUTH IN ACTION, believes accountability must be a part of every institution in society to promote Order and excellence. In marriage preparations, school admissions, leadership positions in schools, job interviews at various work places and so on and so for, there must be the right procedures enacted in selecting and recommending the right spouses, selected applicants for admissions in tertiary institutions, student leaderships and selection of private and public workers, so that the society can grow in the right direction. If the right people are selected for the right work, there will be progression in every field of development but if the wrong people are selected from the right work, there will be conflict and chaos everywhere. Everyone is significant one way or the other, but they must be found doing what they can do best.



4. RULE OF LAW

In every democratic society, the rule of law must be the pivot and the basis under which every human institution in the National Anatomy operates. In every democratic dispensation, there must be a constitution which denotes the do and dons of the land, which serves as a guide for every person to live by, for the security, peace and prevalence of harmony in the nation. If the systems are not laid rightly, there will be conflicts and malfunctions in our Governing systems which will lead to a rollercoaster system of Governance, rather than a progressional system of Government. The codified laws of a country even guide the system and path of democracy in the nation. People are guided and led on a path, to behave and act in honest ways, which do not infringe on the liberties and rights of others. This creates harmony right from the family level to the Government level and ensures the integrity of every individual as a means of promoting National Peace Building. There must be a structured set of codes, way of living, beliefs, guides, tenets, values and laws in every system, which serves as a pathway to guide individuals to live in the right way, which will promote decent living and encourage Participatory Nation Building in the society. **YOUTH IN ACTION** believes no one was created as a unique human being to be exempted from living in morality and dispositions that ensure Tranquillity and Justice. **YOUTH IN ACTION**, believes that if the nation wants to thrive, then everyone must be guided by the Rule of Law in our countries, for a safe living and sound development in our continents. This will create an enabling environment for everyone to be innovative, creative and nationalistic without being side-lined, distracted or intimidated. **YOUTH IN ACTION** believes in the core values of FREEDOM for humanity, for a sound living. The nation can be better, when we all agree to work conscientiously in agreement with the laws of the country. This is the only way, people can revolutionize the continent.

5. FREEDOM OF THE PRESS

The Press is a very quintessential institution in the security of every country's democracy. The Press must serve as an independent and most importantly neutral institution, which gives out vital international and local information concerning Governance, Politics, Society and Culture, Sports, Entertainment, religion, Science



and Technology, Business and all other essential information in the country and beyond. This arm serves as a neutral check on the Government and all other Institutions, Companies and Services as well as Daily activities running in the country. The nature of stories given out by the Press concerning the Politics of the State, State Institutions, activities going on in the nation, goes a long way to determine the integrity of the particular state. This is the most important reason, why the Press must be very credible. The Press must have their liberty and not be restrained by any political leader, repressive forces in the system or oppressed in any way by the populace. The press must have their liberty to go about their duties in peace and harmony. These are one of the credible ways, by which the Government can be transparent and work decently and avoid corruption and indecent practices, in their services and operations. Where the government of a nation is performing well, she will gain admiration by other countries through international media companies. This will encourage foreign aid and mutual harmony, as well as boost International relations and trade amongst various countries.

RIGHTS OF AN INDIVIDUAL ENJOYED UNDER DEMOCRATIC DISPENSATION

1. RIGHT TO JOIN ANY POLITICAL PARTY

YOUTH IN ACTION, believes that every individual has the right to join every political party he or she wants. **YOUTH IN ACTION** believes that no individual should be estranged or forced to join a particular political party due to hereditary, racial or tribal relations or even mere friendships one may have with a member of a particular political party. **YOUTH IN ACTION**, believes every individual is of particular significance in the welfare of the country which makes him or her, essential to the development of the country. Everyone's decisions count, and as such they should be given the fair nod to air out their views, as their views one way or the other will lead to the total and wholesome progressive advancement in the development of the country. **YOUTH IN ACTION**, believes that every individual should have a fair opportunity and the freedom to choose which political party, he/she wants to join. The goal of every individual should be targeted towards the



acceleration of the nation's development and not the promotion of the dignity of a particular political party.

2. RIGHT TO VOTE

YOUTH IN ACTION believes that it is the right of everyone as a citizen of a country to vote. **YOUTH IN ACTION** entreats everyone to vote as citizens of their respective nations in the African anatomy. 3. RIGHT TO LIFE

YOUTH IN ACTION believes that every single individual deserves the right to life. **YOUTH IN ACTION**, believes that every individual has a unique and well deserving and rewarding destiny, which must be rewarded and respected. No group of people or society, or nation must in anyway try to infringe on the rights of any human being. Everyone deserves the right to life. Everyone deserves a good and quality life and a good way of living. No one must be treated harshly, abused, have

their rights trampled upon or be forced to do what they do not like. The atrocity that is caused to humanity by others must stop. Humans must have their freewill to decide what they want, where they want to be, how they want things to be done and when they want to do it, what they want to do and whichever way they want it. People must be treated with patience, tolerance and love. Humans must appreciate the quality of life, and value their life and the life they live. It is only in this way, which people can express their Freedom to the highest degree and give in back to their society. Let us rise up, and treat humanity with dignity. It is not only the existence of humanity, that bequeaths their right to life, but their luxurious way of living, that makes them cherish the life they are living here on earth. Let us make sure that our emotional, social and psychological dispositions bring FREEDOM to those we have encounters with. Let us make sure our utterances and behaviours are ones that bring liberation to humanity.

4. FREEDOM OF SPEECH

YOUTH IN ACTION believes every individual has the right to air out their views, as humans concerned with the development of their society. YOUTH IN ACTION believes every individual is significant in one way or the other and has a spectacle from which no one else can see things from that lenses. It is in this view that everyone, must be given the right to voice out their views and suggestions concerning issues in their family, society, religion, institution, workplace and nation. No one must be limited or refrained from expressing their views and opinions, about how the nation should go. Everyone must be treated with fairness and dignity, and this is how, the nation can grow and become, what she ought to be, through the collaborative suggestions and opinions of others. There should not be discrimination, as to what is given much attention, and what is neglected and disregarded. An excellent nation is one that considers the opinions of the entire citizenry. The freedom we want prevailing in the nation, can only thrive where there is equity in relation to people's right to voice out their views. This strengthens our democracy and promotes Tranquillity, Harmony and Justice in our nations.



5. FREEDOM FROM DISCRIMINATION

YOUTH IN ACTION believes in human equality and the centralisation of order as the pivot in governing human living. YOUTH IN ACTION believes that no group of people should be categorised or placed above other group of people. No group, tribe or institution should be treated lightly, in relation to the other. Akans should not be seen as a better ethnic group than the Ibos and so should the Ibos not also be seen as a better ethnic group than the Akans. We are all human beings who aim to have a better living, and must live in peace. People who try show behaviours that reflect cases of superiority complexes, must in no way be accommodated and tolerated. All kinds of humans from different backgrounds are significant and peculiar and must not be mistreated and discriminated. They all deserve the right to life, and not just life but also to good and quality standards of living. Everyone must experience freedom in their life, where they feel they are not being inhibited or mistreated or prevented from living their lives to the fullest. Everyone is unique and must be treated fairly. All kinds of alacritous schemes which make people feel rejected and neglected must be pulverised. People must be able to live freely and express themselves freely.

6. RIGHT TO PERSONAL LIBERTY

YOUTH IN ACTION believes that every human being is of value and significant to national development, and must be able to have the best of life, and live their life to the most. **YOUTH IN ACTION**, believes people must not be deprived of their rights or be treated as slaves. **YOUTH IN ACTION**, believes everyone deserves the best of life, everywhere they are, and must be allowed to bring out what they have within them, to bring liberation to their society and affect humanity positively. People must be able to freely decide, choose and live the kind of life, they want to live. This entails, the course they want to offer in school, the kind of work they want to be in, the kind of church they want to go, the person they want to marry and the life they want to live, which will one way or the other, affect humanity positively. People must be confident about their lives and must see theirselves as people of worth, wherever they are. This will boost their confidence to contribute to society anyway, they can and make society a better place. In places where people feel they

are loved and feel secured, they will always want to give in their best and be ambassadors of FREEDOM, wherever they are. The right to personal liberty is quintessential right, which must be given equal attention, just as given to other rights, to promote the Freedom, humanity, must walk in, in this democratic dispensation.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF AN AFRICAN INDIVIDUAL IN A DEMOCRATIC DISPENSATION

1. DEFEND THE CONSTITUTIONS OF OUR COUNTRIES

It is the duty of the African individual to protect his continent by being an excellent adherent of his or her nation's constitution. It is the responsibility of every individual to work expediently and also at the same time, excellently in whatever occupation, one is engaged in. When people Work expediently and excellently, it creates a system of efficiency in all sorts of work, which leads to a sustained improvement in the development of the country. The various recommendations **YOUTH IN ACTION**, has given as criterion to change the scope of Governance across Africa, are expounded below.
